## OUR HISTORY

The Alannah & Madeline Foundation was set up in memory of Alannah and Madeline Mikac, aged six and three who were tragically killed with their mother and 32 others at Port Arthur, Tasmania on 28 April 1996.

Our programs are in one third of all Australian schools and more than half of all Australian public libraries, and we support 10,000 children in refuges or foster homes across Australia every year. We have helped almost 2 million children and their families nationwide since we began in 1997.

**eSmart Libraries is a cyber safety framework designed to fully equip libraries, staff and library users with the skills they need for smart, safe and responsible use of digital technology.**

Public libraries are the most heavily used community centres in Australia, and reach out to some of the most disadvantaged members of our society. More than half of the population are public library members, who make over 110 million visits a year to 1,500 public libraries across Australia. More than half of these libraries are already participating in the eSmart Libraries program.

The eSmart Libraries Framework has been developed from a holistic and evidence-based approach, and considers how the library and community can develop smart, safe and responsible digital behaviours.

A recent survey of registered libraries across the country revealed that:

- **100% of Library managers feel competent and confident online to support library users to use technology in the library**
- **100% of Library managers state that eSmart Libraries has made a difference to cyber safety and the management of cyber bullying**
- **100% of Library managers would recommend the eSmart Libraries initiative to another library service**

There is no fee for public libraries to join, and libraries will gain access to the evidence-based framework, resources, newsletters and support.

eSmart Libraries is a partnership between the Alannah & Madeline Foundation and the Telstra Foundation. It is one of the most significant community cyber safety initiatives ever undertaken in Australia. The Telstra Foundation has invested \$8 million to implement eSmart Libraries in all 1,500 public libraries, as part of their commitment to make a positive and lasting difference to communities across Australia.
