Twitter enables you to see what's happening in the world right now. We want to enable you to better control what you see and who you interact with on Twitter.


Two features to improve your experience, easily accessible from your Notifications settings:

Only people you follow

- Don't want to see notifications from everyone? Now you can limit notifications so you only see mentions, Retweets, and likes from people you follow, as well as a notification when someone new follows you.
- · This setting is easily accessible via Notifications settings.

Quality filter

- Quality filter helps you control what you see in your Notifications timeline. When turned on, the filter will improve the quality of Tweets you'll see. Learn more.
- This feature is turned on by default, so no extra work is required to enable it. Anyone can turn off this feature via Notifications settings.
